Free Eyes Check-up Camp was organised By Indian Plumbing Association - Mumbai Chapter with support of well-known Ophthalmologist, Dr. Kulin Kothari's Vision Foundation (to be confirmed) of India for the students of MKLM School, Hostel, Jr.College and Ma Vidhyadham degree College on 21st November 2019 at their campus-Vile Parle (W), Mumbai.

Nearly 446 students from Pre-Primary & Secondary school to Degree college and Girls Hostel have preregistered, participated and benefitted from the camp including teachers and staff members.

A team of experts were deputed by Vision Foundation of India, including -Ophthalmologist, Dr. Shivani Pattnayak and Optometrist, Pankaj Thakur. The camp started from 9.30 AM till 3.00 PM. Free Spectacles were given to needy students by Matushree Kantaben Kalyaji Ghelani family, which made this camp more fruitful.

The students who needed further check-up and treatment for any complications were issued letters by Vision Foundation of India for free/nominal cost treatment at their Hospital at Babulnath Mumbai. Post the camp, the teachers will follow up with such students and their parents.
